
The Body Slides

Welcome to Wild Waterworks

Wild Waterworks now has four tube slides. Try Wild Waterworks' Night Rider, Blue Demon and the Vertigo and Sidewinder tube slides. Go solo or with a friend as you slide 5.5-stories down to the Eazy River. Move on and surf the waves in one of Canada's largest outdoor wave pools. Over a million gallons of heated water splash down every minute. The fun continues with the heart-pounding twists of the Kamikaze and Corkscrew – the park's six-storey body slides. Toddlers will love Little Squirt Works, a fun wading pool with computer-controlled sprays, mists and fountains. Catch all the fun Wild Waterworks has to offer from the first weekend in June to Labour Day. Group picnic areas and pavilions are also available inside Wild Waterworks. Get lost in the dark or race to the bottom as you slide 5.5 stories down these mind blowing tube rides and plunge into the Eazy River.


Vertigo and Side Winder

Our most recent attractions built in 2008 are these two exhilarating tube slides. Enjoy the rush as you barrel down the unexpected twists and drops of these rides.


The Body Slides

Please note the following height restrictions on the water slides: Night Rider and Blue Demon: 47 inches (119.38 centimeters) or successful completion of a swim test. Kamikaze and Corkscrew Body Slides, Vertigo and Sidewinder Tube Slides: 42 inches (106.68 centimeters).



Welcome to Confederation Park

Confederation Park is a 83-hectare package of fun and adventure located on the shores of Lake Ontario in Hamilton. Here you'll find some of the area's best food and fun throughout the year. 

Things to know before you go to Wild Waterworks:

To help you plan your trip to Wild Waterworks, please note:

- ◆ Proper swimwear will be required for all water attractions. No goggles, sunglasses, eyeglasses, life jackets or t-shirts allowed on slides.
- ◆ For the little ones, only government-approved life jackets or P.F.D.s may be worn in the pool, and river. Water wings are permitted in Little Squirt Works. If your child is not toilet-trained, they must wear either swim diapers or plastic pants over a diaper in water attractions.
- ◆ Masks, fins, snorkels or other water toys are not permitted in the wave pool.
- ◆ You are allowed to bring in a picnic cooler or bag. However, glass, barbeques and alcohol are not permitted. Wild Waterworks reserves the right to inspect bags or coolers prior to park entry.
- ◆ Please leave the toys at home: balls, Frisbees, radios and other audio devices are not permitted.
- ◆ There are height restrictions on the water slides. For Night Rider and Blue Demon tube slides, you must be 47 inches (119.38 centimeters) or successfully complete a swim test. For Kamikaze and Corkscrew body slides and Vertigo and Sidewinder tube slides, you must be 42 inches (106.68 centimeters).
